
## Photo booth Mask

use the photo booth to take a distorted picture of yourself







## distortion is important!

avoid light tunnel and kaleidoscope effects




Use your own ipad or iphone or borrow one in class form Ms Bowyer


you will save your photos on the ipad and email your best 2 to your own email

you will print out your top 2 and re-draw one using a grid. Finally, add chalk or paint to create colour











Divide your picture up evenly.


An easy way to do this is to FOLD it!



Set your photo on your paper. Use a meter stick and measure corner to corner. Cut off the extra bit and your page will be the same ratio.




Now **lightly** draw the same number of squares on your good paper. 4 x 4 You may use math to calculate the size.




Look at one square at a time

No really.
This is important

Also look at it upside down



For part with a lot of information it helps to divide it up again





Try to draw the shape of the highlight (the bright area) and the shadow (the dark area) You don't have to fill in the shapes because you will be using paint for that.

## **CHOOSE SOME STRANGE COLOURS**

Choose a colour for your highlight and an analogous colour for your shadow. Or use tints and shades of your original colour making it MONOchromatic



Some Samples: remember weird colours and simplify the shapes of the highlights and the shadows
